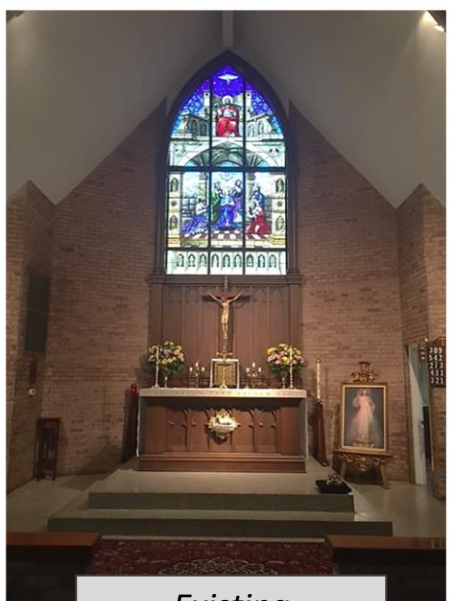

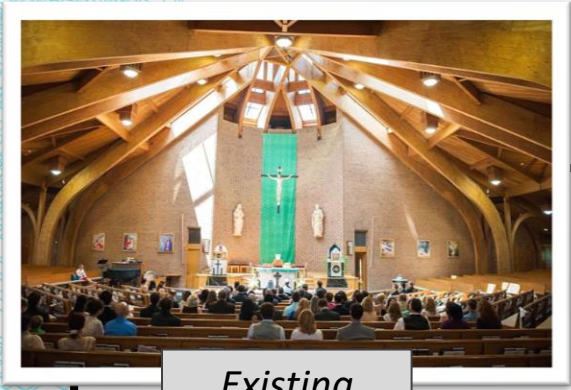

Narthex Grille Detail

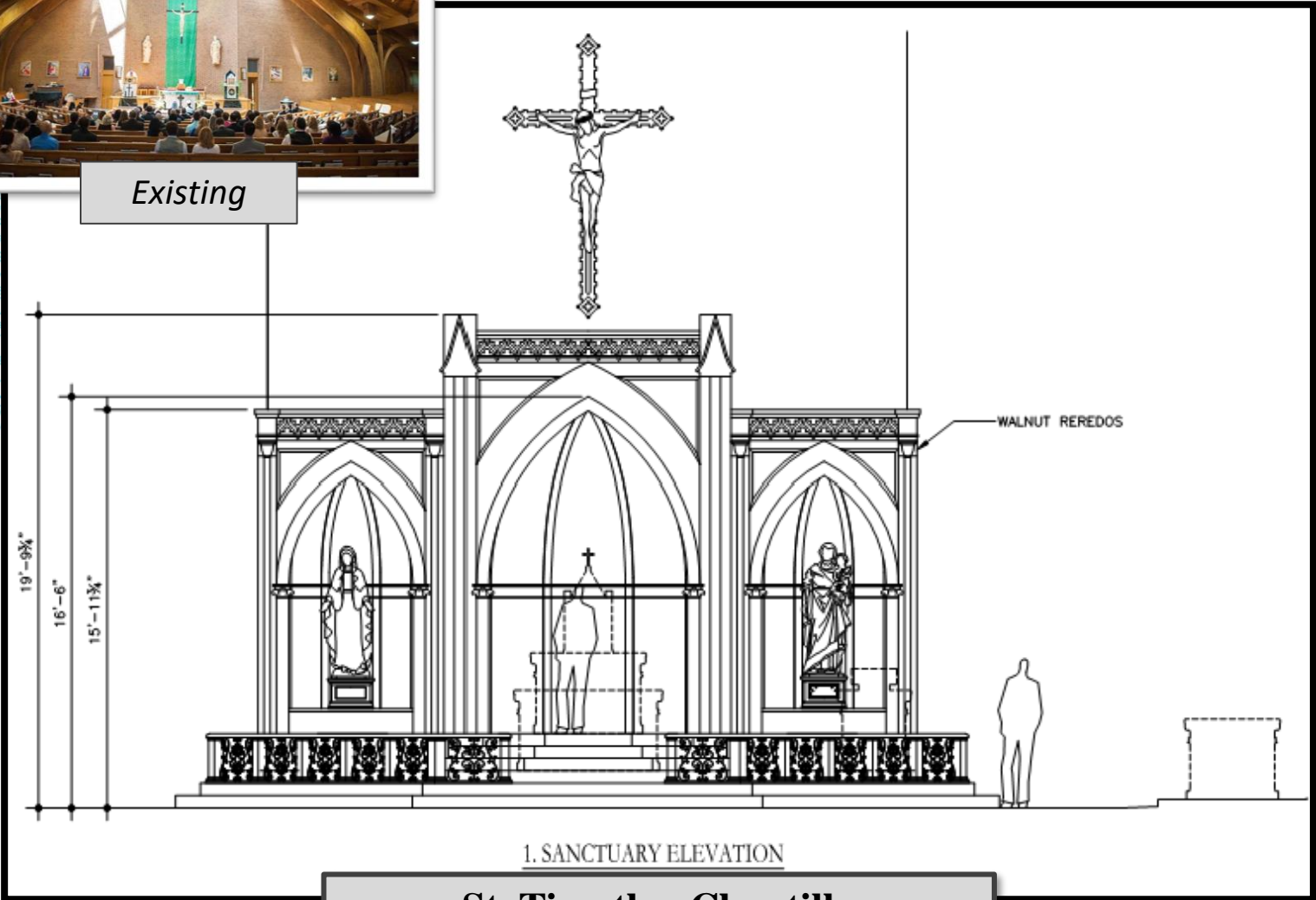

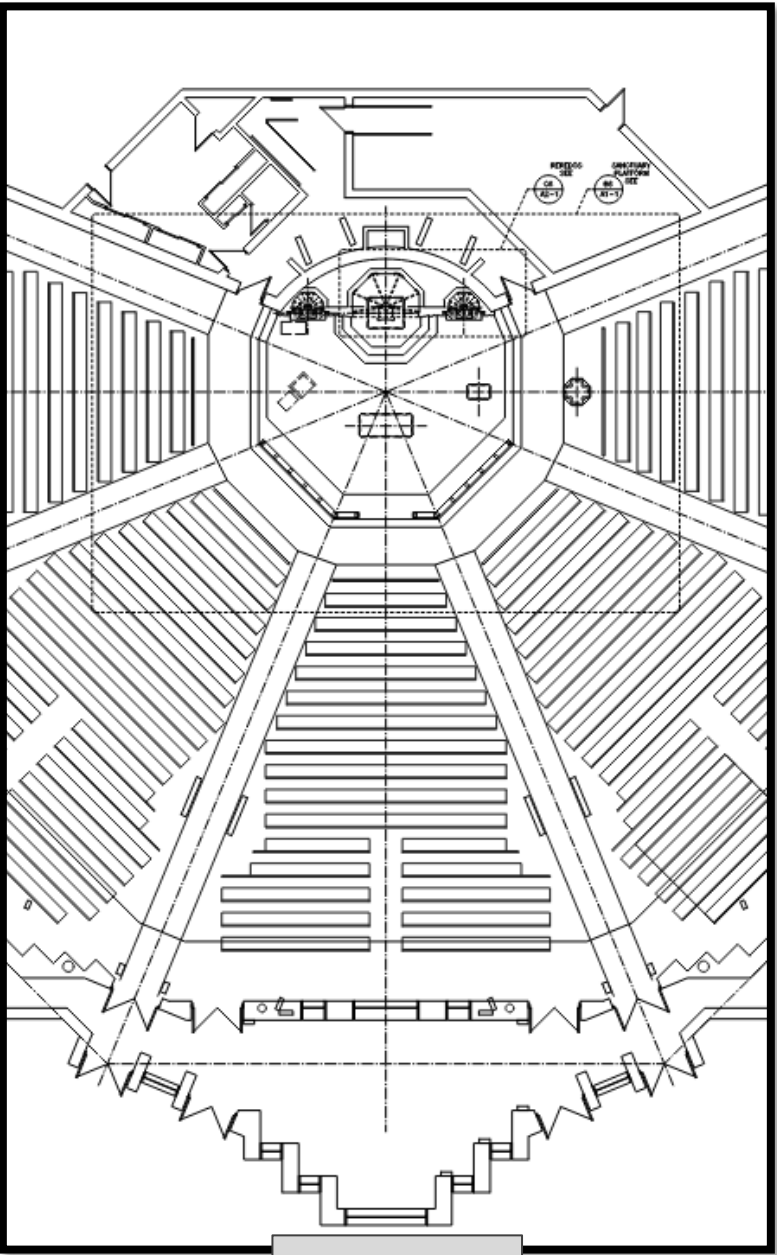

1. SANCTUARY ELEVATION

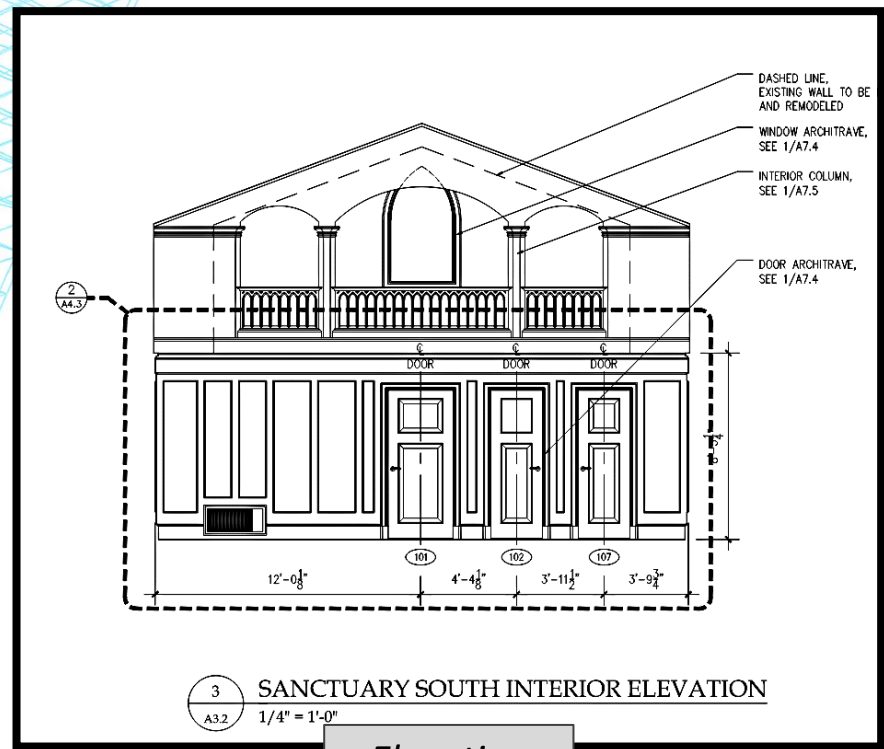

Proposed Sanctuary Renovation



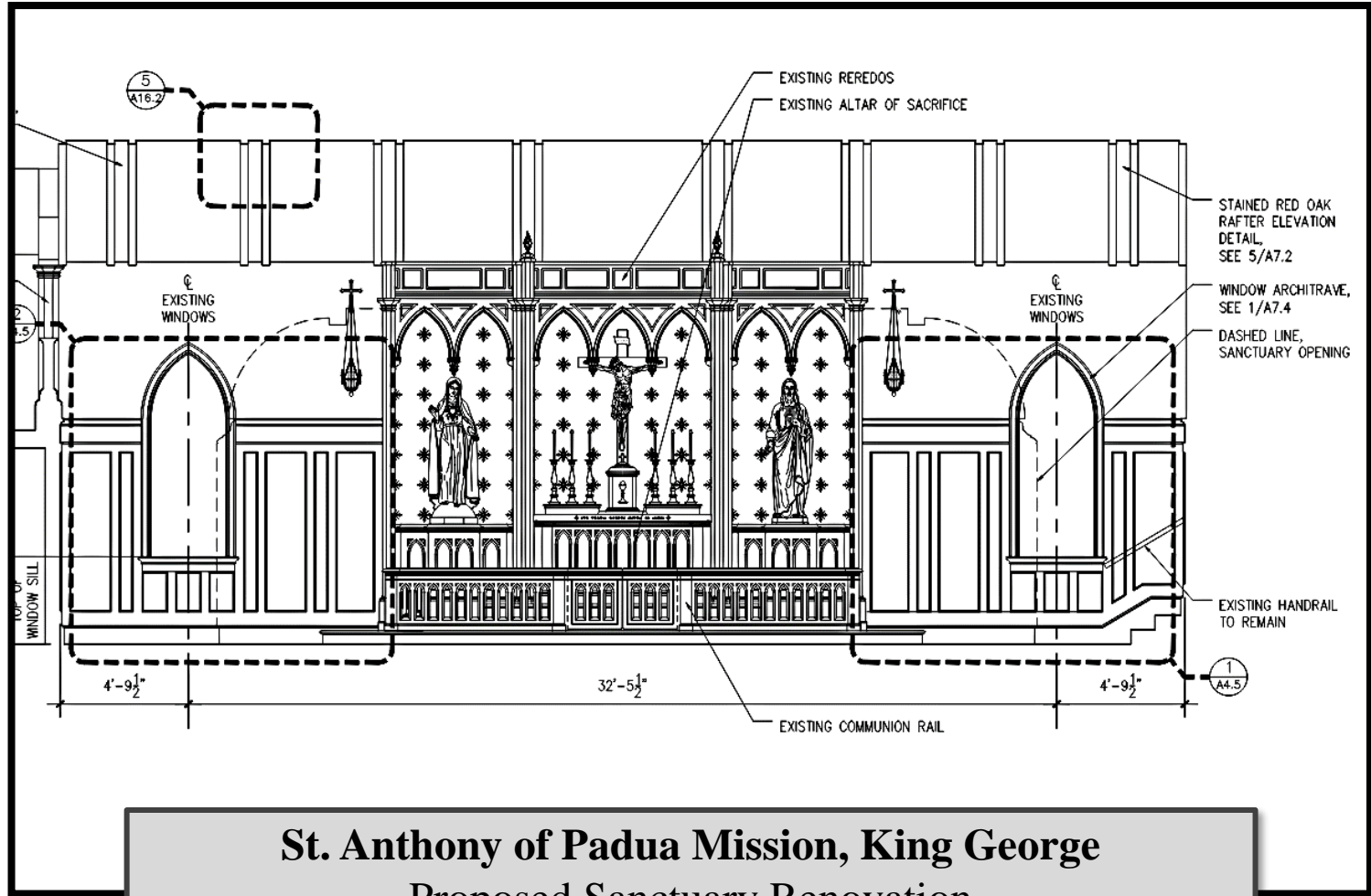

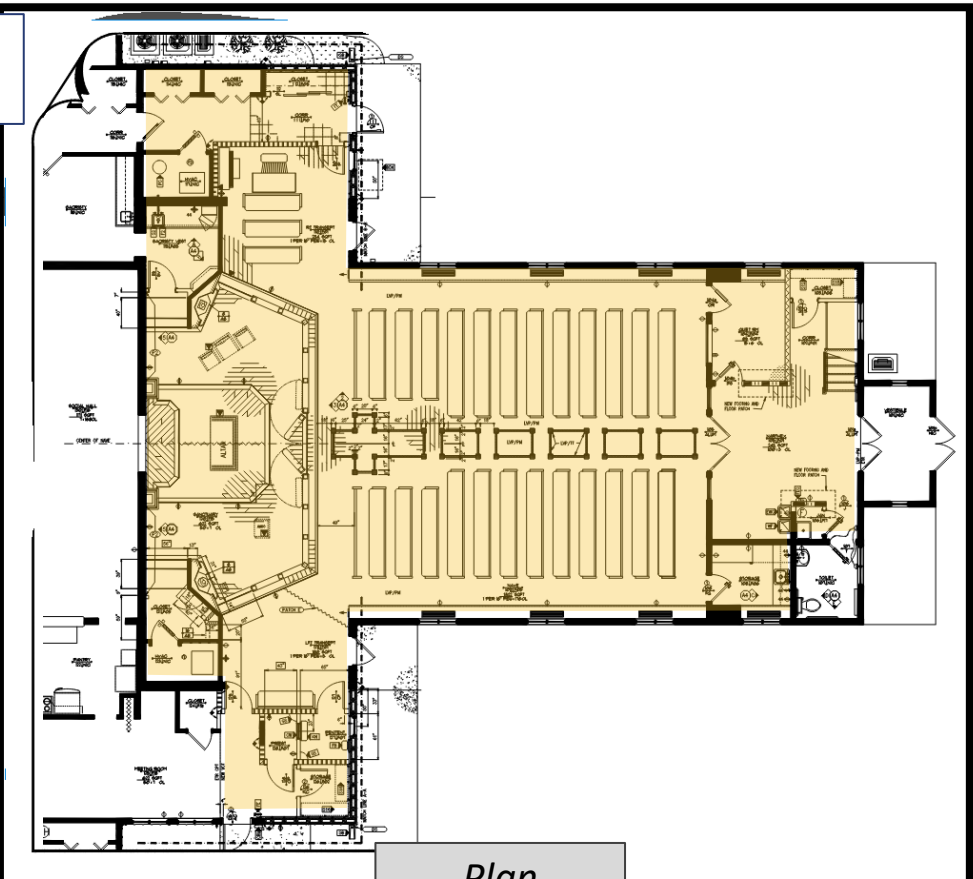

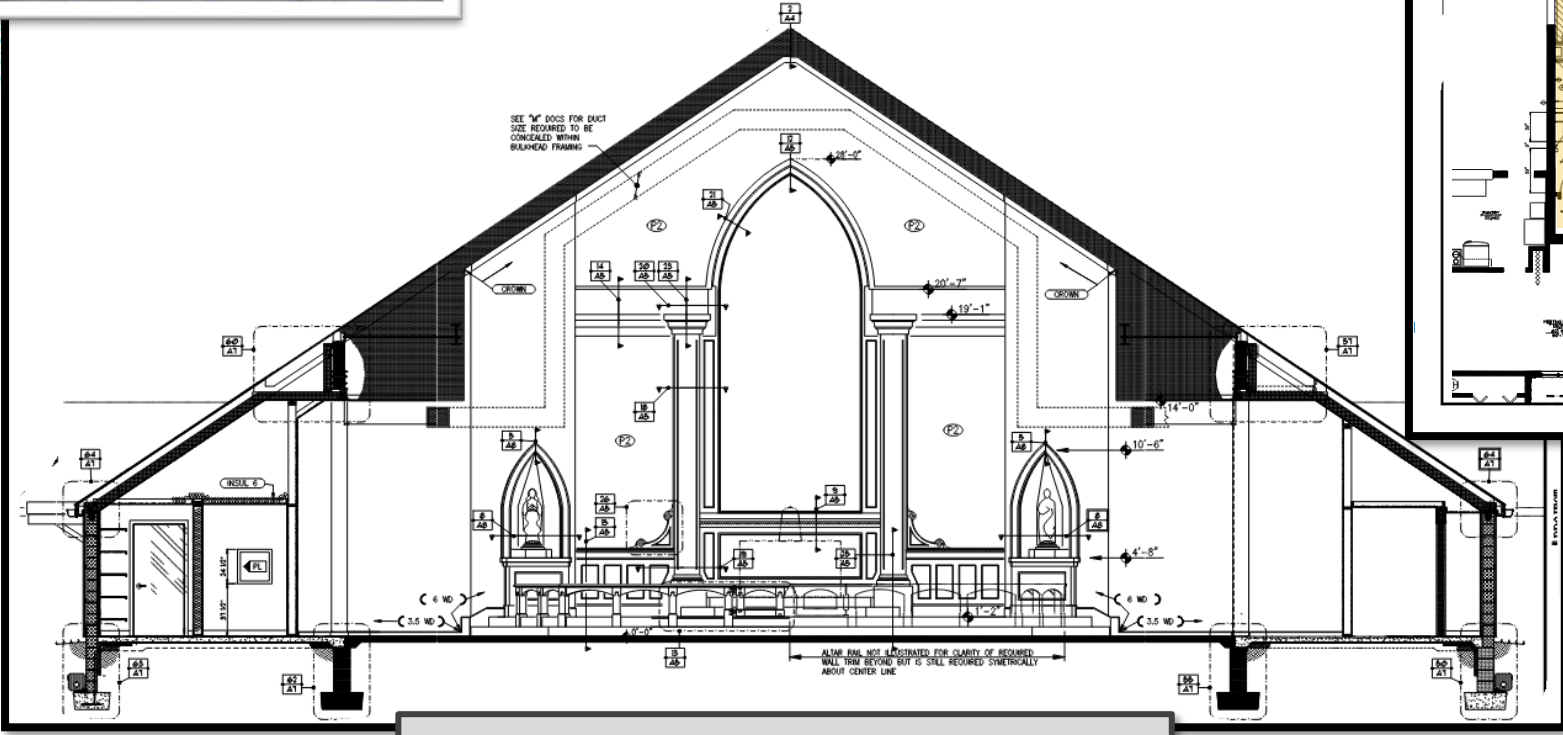
St. Anthony of Padua Mission, King George Proposed Sanctuary Renovation

Energy & Environment:

- **BULK PURCHASE OF NATURAL GAS:**
 - Parish/school purchases from NOVEC Energy Solutions for a set term & price lower than current rates
- **SOLAR ROOF TOPS:**
 - A power purchase agreement between a contractor and the Diocese of Arlington to fund, design, construct, own and operate solar photovoltaic systems on agreed-upon Parish/School rooftops
 - Parish/school agrees to “buy back” the electricity generated on the rooftop at relatively low rate
- **ENERGY AUDITS:**
 - A no-cost energy audit for parish and school facilities
 - Engineers will evaluate the current use of energy (electricity, natural gas, and water) used by a parish/school to identify opportunities to reduce consumption, and in most cases improve comfort and overall performance of your building systems
 - Could lead to construction projects that provide significant savings to your operational budget
