## DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. The Epiphany celebrates publicly that Jesus has come into the world and is the fullness of all that we have waited for. Why do you think this was celebrated as the great feast in the Ancient Church?
2. Why do you think God became man?
3. How can we see the Lord currently dwelling amongst us?
4. Jesus is the fullness of Revelation, which means that in him – all that God wants made known about himself is revealed in Christ. He is all that man has been waiting for. In Jesus, we see the reality of who we are and why we need a savior. How can we come to live differently because Jesus came to dwell amongst us?
